Griffin:

Justin:

(singing)

Griffin:

Justin:

(laughs)

Travis:

Griffin:

Griffin:

Travis:

Griffin:

Griffin:

Griffin:

Justin:

Handsome beret, Steven. How about Army Wives last night?

Travis:

Justin:

Griffin:

Let's go-

Justin:

Are you saying-

Griffin:

Let's go to this club in the city.

Justin:

Griffin:

(laughs) I enjoy it. You will enjoy it too, Steven.

Justin:

I, I suspect you will enjoy it, Steven. I suspect you will enjoy me. If not, wait for tomorrow and my hat will be far more provocative than it is at the moment. Formspring. Griffin:

Travis:

Justin:

(laughs)

Griffin:

Yes. He also has that cyber power.

Justin:

You mean soul power?

Travis:

No.

Griffin:

He has that soul power from the cyber legislation held in techno congress.

Travis:

(laughing)

Griffin:

There was a cyber bill in techno congress that gave him the power to go back in time and stop events from happening.

Justin:

Android of the house, can you pass the oil so I can...

Griffin:

The 22nd amendment hasn't been repealed. It's been fucking-

Travis:

Erased.

Griffin:

... de-written. It's been de, de-erased.

Justin:

It's been unthought.

Travis:

Can I just say, we have just written the greatest movie ever.

Griffin:

Time Travel President.

Travis:

Yes.

Griffin:

Starring Bill Pullman?

Justin:

It's digital legislation and soul power. Every time I hear digital legislation, I think of [inaudible 00:27:31] with Minority Report gloves on, manipulating events. (laughs) Uh, so, uh...

Griffin:

To answer your question, yes of course, there will be a god damn election in 2012, you idiot child.

Justin:

But the only thing we're electing is a, is a new president of the collapsed society we have because there's no more internet. It's just, like, wolf men and...

Travis:

(laughs)

Justin:

Uh, so...

Travis:

Travis:

Griffin:

... and suspects. Yeah. (laughs)

Travis:

No, it was natural causes. Again.

Griffin:

We don't see any weapon wounds or signs of entry at all. Um, it looks like he just fell down in the bathtub and he, and he hurt himself and he just kinda died there cause he was old.

Travis:
