They're attached to our face, uh, which is great, uh, 'cause, there's... I, I, I don't know if you guys know this. I produce the show and I, I edit it, uh, which I think are the same thing. Uh...

[laughs]


Griffin:

Well, well done. Um, so first before we really delve into the meat of the question, if people around you think your clothes are weird, but you think it works, that's pretty much the definition of your clothes not working.

Travis:

If you're talking about clothes working, you are covering all your, like, gentle bits.

Justin:

[laughs] Yeah, right. You're protected from the immediate elements, like, yeah, I guess in that [crosstalk].

Travis:


I think everyone has a favorite pair of jeans, right?

Justin: What's up, half of the alienated crowd? [crosstalk] [laughs]

Travis: Wait. Do you think anyone in here isn't on board with Doug?

[laughs]


Griffin:

"... and I've seen people on 1000 Ways to Die die in hot tubs for a few different reasons. Uh, If I get..." They had a whole special. It was just-



Griffin: Like, don't-
Justin: Yeah.
Griffin: go near hot tubs maybe. Like, if you hear, like, rolling-
Travis: [crosstalk] You guys wanna go to a hot tub? No.
Griffin: I hear jets, I hear rolling water. I hear-
Travis: Have you guys ever encountered a surprise hot tub?

Like, you turn the corner and it's like, "Oh, what's that, what's that pit of foamy spew?"

I've gotta-

Griffin:

It's like, "Aw fuck, it's a hot tub! No!"

I've got a Boy Scout induction that I want you... Hot tub! No, it doesn't- it's always on vacation and...

Griffin:

How do you relax your joints without hot tubs? It's like a fucking bath tub! Quit being an idiot, Jessica!

Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin:

It's a fucking bath tub that's, like, square instead of rectangular, you dummy!

Audience:

[laughs]

Justin:

Do you think she's afraid of bath tubs, too? Like, like if someone rounded out their bath tub, she would freak out as it was [unintelligible].

Griffin:

Do you think I... Do you know what? I have a theory. I think it is the communal experience of a hot tub over a bath tub, which I totally agree with, because we've talked about hot tubs before. Like, you're getting your balls' particles in a soup with everyone else's balls' particles.

"Chaz baby, where's your face bling?" And he's, like, "I don't... My parents are total squares, man. Like, I don't know what to tell you."

Wait, wait. Whoa, whoa. Were you... Those of you at home, Griffin just did the square motion with his finger. Is it 1962?

I, I'm bringing it back. Um...

Travis:

Retro.

Griffin:

I don't, I don't know. I think if you *don't* let your baby get an earring, your male fucking hip ass baby...

Justin: This is my baby, Tyke Tyson.
Griffin: How-
Audience: [laughs]
Justin: Thank you. Thank you for your [crosstalk].
Griffin: How old, how old does a human being-'cause that's what they are. They're, like, pocket-sized human beings.
Justin: Yeah.
Audience: [laughs]
Griffin: How old do they have to be before they can start expressing themselves?
Travis: Let's hear it, audience?
Griffin:

That's right. Zero.

Justin: It's an in-baby-able right.
Griffin: As soon as seed touches egg, it's like, that baby's, like-
Justin: What-
Griffin: you know, experimenting with
Justin: You thought it was okay?
Travis: I thought it was a good joke.
Justin: In-baby-able. I don't know.
Travis: In-baby-able right? No?
Griffin: We'll-
Justin: We can edit it out later.

Travis: Yeah.

Justin: Exactly.

We'll take that out. It's coming out in post.

Justin:

They let them see prison movies.

Griffin:

What? Can you explain?

Justin:

Es- Escape from Alcatraz, shit like that. [crosstalk]

Griffin:

Nah, see, I thought that same thing. Shawshank.

Justin:

No, Shawshank, the [crosstalk].

Travis:

These are all escape movies!

Griffin:

That's what I'm saying. Like, you don't want to give these prisoners any ideas. Are there any movies where there are people who are in jail and they're like, "Yeah."

Travis:

"I accept this."

Griffin:

"This is pretty fucking cool. Like, hey, I can lift weights and stuff. Like, all my friends are-not-well, they're not here, but my new friends are".

Justin:

They show *Shawshank*, but they cut it at the part where Morgan Freeman wants to go back to prison. And they a have little credits that come up at the end. Like, "And then he went back to prison and he was happy forever."

Travis: "Have you met anybody interesting?"
Justin: Yeah.
Griffin: Yeah. Uh, soap jokes are, like, right out the window. Like-
Justin: No, no soap jokes.
Griffin: Um, I don't know. Is there any way that, that sort of splits those uprights?

[laughs]



Griffin: She's been imagined away.

Justin:

"I thought I was already!" Nope, you done fucked up.

Justin:

Oh, now, it'll only be like that for her whole, whole life.

Griffin:

[laughs]

Audience:

[laughs]

Travis:

[crosstalk] She's owns a cat named Donny Osmond.

Griffin:

I don't know. In a few years...

Audience:

[laughs]

And by the way, it's a puppy is the gag, you dumb shit.

Griffin:

Damn it!

Justin:

'Puppy Lo-' oh, it's right there.

Griffin:

Um, I feel like, let's give it three years, okay?

Justin:

Okay.

Griffin:

She's 18. She's of age now. Literally nobody else knows who Donny Osmond is.

Audience:

[laughs]

Travis:

Not even Donny Osmond. Riddled with Alzheimer's.

Griffin:

Fucking *Marie* Osmond is, like, "Hey, what's... Oh, Donny! God, I'm so sorry. Uh, Merry Christmas."

Audience:

Griffin:

'Cause it's Christmas time when this situation takes place?

Justin:

Justin:

Griffin:

I'm saying she knows *Bradley* Cooper.

Justin:

Not Mr. Cooper. She's not hanging with him.

Griffin:

She's not hanging... She is, she's gonna make that joke at the wedding. [laughs] 'Cause it's gonna be awkward. She doesn't know Brad very well.

Justin:

Oh, B-Rad?

Travis:

So she doesn't know Bradley Cooper, like, she is acquainted with Brad-

Griffin:

... hanging with Bradley Cooper.

Justin:

You mean B-Radley Cooper?

Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin:

Um...

Justin:

If she shows up with Bradley Cooper and B-Radley Cooper, then you're in trouble. 'Cause that's a splinter verse situation.

Audience:

[laughs]

Travis:

Uh, I would say, you just go. Like, I think you're past the point of... It's nice of you to care, but you don't have to.

Justin:

[laughs] [unintelligible] that guy.

Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin:

[laughs] Yeah!

Justin:

He learned how to fight from Quinton "Rampage" Jackson and Liam Neeson. They told him the ropes.

Griffin:

Your other option is to get Quinton "Rampage" Jackson or Liam Neeson to go with you, just as moral support. Um...

Justin:

[laughs] They'll diffuse the si-

Travis:

You think you're gonna turn them?

Griffin:

I think you could probably do it.

Justin:

They'll diffuse the situation much like I imagine they diffused a bomb in the hit film *The A-Team*. I haven't seen it.

Griffin:

No.

Justin:

I'm told it's excellent.

Griffin:

Uh, your third option is just *try* to make her feel bad for you. "What's up?" Like-

Justin:

Whoa, reverse!

Griffin:

"[dejected] No, I'm, uh... I'm flyin' solo this time."

Justin:

[laughs]

Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin:

"I see you brought Bradley Cooper. Bradley, I loved you in Hangover."

Travis:

I haven't seen Hangover Part II, but I assume it's good.

Justin:

"I been trying to get a girl to go with me to it but you know, going to the movies alone is such a-"

Griffin:

"It's hard because I don't have your, um, I mean your good looks or your self-confidence."

Justin:

"Or your money."

Griffin:

"Your money, your, your [quietly] fame."

Audience:

[laughs]

"Or your love-making skills, I'm assuming. I don't know Bradley Cooper personally."

Griffin:

"[tearfully] I'm going to wait in line for the apertifs. I'll, uh... Susan, it was great to see you." [crosstalk]

Griffin:

Like a child's party toy. Hey, how about a Yahoo Answers?

Justin:

Yeah, please.

Griffin:

Uh... uh... how much time we have left?

Justin:

10 minutes. Go.

Griffin:

Jesus. Uh, this one was sent in by Blake. Thank you, Blake, it's by Yahoo Answers user Idiotic, who asks, "If drugs are legalized, does that mean I will find needles and used items in my hamburger/food?"

Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin:

"When legalization passes and heroin addicts are accepted into the service sector?"

Travis:

Hey, of course!

Justin:

Hey, dog, what do you think heroin addicts are doing now?

Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin:

Oh, that's a good point.

Travis:

When they legalize it and they have to quit their jobs as professors and doctors.

Audience:

[laughs]

Justin:

Right. Exactly.

Griffin:

"Uh, Reggie, that's a... Reggie, that's a pretty sweet score that you have there. Uh, what are you up to nowadays?"

"Oh, I'm a bank manager... /heroin addict. I manage a Chase Bank on the corner, and on the weekends, I just fucking pound that hammer in."

Travis:

Just heroin it up. 2007.

Griffin:

Um, yeah, they do work at McDonald's. That's a... A lot of people didn't know that.

Justin:

Not only, not exclusively McDonald's. Like, people who work in McDonald's aren't necessarily heroin addicts.

Travis:

And not only that, when they work at McDonald's, put their used needles directly into the [crosstalk]-

Griffin:

"Done with this!" Plop. Like... "I'll just fold the burger patty around it."

Travis:

"No one'll notice."

Griffin:

"This feels like more than a quarter pound." "Yeah, I put, um... put a syringe in there. Enjoy that. It's full of special sauce. Wink!"

... you just take crack and you pour it into heroin. Like, that's the next step.

Justin:

Crackoins are actually the, the proudest tribe of Native Americans.

Griffin:

Uh-huh.

Justin: That's true. It's history! Like, I'm not-
Griffin: It's hard to judge. Like, it's hard to-there's no metric for pride, but we're pretty sure it's the Crackoins.
Travis: Yeah.
Griffin: Mmm, that's good. That's good stuff. I hear that, uh-you remember Racks?
Justin: Yeah.
Griffin: Racks shut down because it was 100% heroin addicts.
Justin: Really?
Griffin: Couldn't show up on time, couldn't get that roast beef carved.
Travis: No.
Griffin: Uh, no, like Oh, sorry. Uh, Yahoo Answers user-Richard Karn?! Wait a fucking second.
Justin: Whoa!
Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin: From Home Improvement Fame? Justin: Yeah. Audience:

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[laughs]

Griffin:

Poor Richard Karn. Like, he's probably on the-he's probably on the stuff, right?

Travis:

Whoa, whoa, whoa, whoa.

Griffin:

I don't want to... This isn't the basis of a libel suit, so I'm going to say this is a total fabrication, but Richard Karn definitely uses heroin. [crosstalk]

Yeah, he loves heroin.

Griffin:

Um...

Justin:

I know Tim Allen got him hooked on it.

Griffin:

Do you know why?

Justin:

It might have been Jonathan Taylor Thomas.

Travis:

[sings *Home Improvement* theme song].

Griffin:

That's the *Home Improvement* theme song.

Justin: Yeah! Just for you guys, it's a musical bit we're trying out.
Griffin: [laughs loudly] Listen, Richard Karn went to Tim Allen, fellow <i>definite</i> heroin user, and said, "I need more power."
Justin: [laughs]
Audience: [laughs]
Griffin: And then he grunted, but he wasn't, like, doing to say the thing. It was because he was, like, shooting heroin into his arm.
Justin: Right.
Griffin: So you, you grunt because it hurts.
Justin: Richard Ka- Richard Karn has to watch John O'Hurley just butcher the <i>Family Feud</i> every Thursday, Wednesday, Tuesday. Every weekday night, he's there.
Griffin: That's not how I would have done it.

Justin:

Griffin: Um-

Justin:

"Hey, neighbor."

Griffin:

"Hey, neighbor." Uh-

Justin:

"Jacked up on the stuff, neighbor."

Griffin:

"Hey, neighbor, I see your track marks. Uh, bad idea."

Justin:

"Get, get clean, neighbor."

Griffin:

Wilson's been around the fucking block. You wouldn't know it because you don't see him outside of the confines of his back yard.

Griffin:

Travis:

Covered in tattoos.

Griffin:

Just covered in tats, track marks, and heroin stains.

Justin:

That's why he was behind the fence. He was riding the-riding the-the-the lightning. Riding in the...

Justin:

Is that a thing? Please tell me that's-if it's a thing. Okay.

Griffin:

No, he's riding the lightning.

Travis:

All the heroin users out there in our audience. [crosstalk]

Griffin:

Straight up H's, we need your help.

Justin:

H-heads.

Griffin:

H, H...

Travis:

That was a test. You passed.

Audience:

[laughs]

Griffin:

We have Smacko.

Justin:

We have sky marshals in the audience. I, I think we have two of those and one of these. So maybe do another one of those.

Griffin:

Justin: Got to move quick though. These people got things to do.
Griffin: This one's sent in by Peter Ermsten. Thank you, Peter. It's by Yahoo Answers user Aduielle, who asks, "My riding instructor told us we need to touch the horse's vagina before we can ride it?" The horse's front butt. "Before we can ride it? That makes no sense to me at all. Is there any truth to this?"

On the planet.


Travis:
