# **Travis**:

Oh, really?

# Griffin:

I'm holding it together with scotch tape and floss.

### Travis:

(laughing uncontrollably)

### **Justin**:

(laughs loudly)

# **Griffin**:

Oh, god.

# Justin:

"At that point, a brief, fleeting lovemaking will commence."

# **Griffin**:

Oh, Jesus. Now I'm just thinking about, like-

# Travis:

"Where are you going?"

### **Griffin**:

I'm thinking about being at a bar, and then, like-

# Justin:

"Excuse me."

# **Griffin**:

And then, like, the- the Lord of House Harkonnen from *Dune*, like, floating over us.

# Travis:

(laughs loudly)

# Griffin:

"Good evening. The spice is life."

# Justin:

"I have a briefcase of spice."

# Griffin:

Oh, Jesus.

### Justin:

There- actually at the end there, there was some Borat thrown in for good measure.

# Travis:

Okay.

# Justin:

People seem to like it.

### **Travis**:

Uh-huh. (affirmative)

# **Griffin**:

Ugh, that crazy Borat guy.

### **Justin**:

Uh, yeah. Like, don't proposition. Maybe just strike up a conversation, see if you have some chemistry.

### Travis:

Yeah.

### Justin:

See if- try that out, maybe. Um, hey. "I'm getting married to the love of my life next year. The thing is, I'm a freelance writer who doesn't make a lot of money. # Justin:

# **Griffin:**

Oh, yes.

# Justin:

Um, the, uh- what my wife and I did, is we actually- we had already been living together when we got married, so we got most of our, like, household appliance-type things. Um, what we did was we had people, uh, we used this site called- I think it's thebigday.com, maybe.

#### Griffin:

#### **Griffin**:

He's not real. He's a computer-generated meme.

#### Travis:

#### **Justin**:

#### **Griffin**:

Yeah.

#### Justin:

A joke that went a little too far.

#### **Griffin**:

He went viral, and he went Zorro. And then he went Zeta. Zeta Jones.

(laughing quietly)

#### Justin:

What a talent she is. Um, so there's-

### **Griffin**:

Also computer generated.

### Justin:

I have to- I don't want to pat us on the back too much, but we had, like, two or three legitimate answers to this question. I feel pretty good about it.

#### Travis:

Yeah.

#### Justin:

Let me take your temperature, Griffin. How do you feel?

#### **Griffin**:

I don't know. I feel like there's- I feel like there's some stuff- I feel like the Texas aspect, I feel like we could explore that.

### **Justin**:

### **Justin**:

### Travis:

### Travis:

Yeah!

### **Griffin**:

Mm-hmm (affirmative).

### Justin:

Griffin-

### Travis:

You know where no- no one ever goes on their honeymoon?

### **Griffin**:

Hmm?

### Travis:

Prison.

# Griffin:

Yeah.

### Justin:

Uh, I beg to- I am adjacent to Logan county. I'm pretty sure some people have gone to prison for their honeymoons, (laughing) sir.

# Griffin:

How about a yahoo?

### Travis:

Yes.

### Justin:

Okay.

Um, this one was sent in by [Fay Stile 00:16:21]. Thank you, Fay Stile. It's via Yahoo Answers user NerdyGameGirlDoll.

### Justin:

Okay.

#### Travis:

Oh.

# Griffin:

Who asks-

### Justin:

She's trying her best.

### **Travis**:

Yeah.

# **Justin**:

Bless her.

### **Griffin**:

"Is it a little extraordinary that I accidentally speak in an English accent?"

### Justin:

(laughs)

### Travis:

Whoa.

### Griffin:

"Every once in a while, I slip into an English accent, even though I was born and raised in Colorado. I can't count to 10-"

Oh, no.

#### Griffin:

"I can't count to 10 with no waiting times without doing it. I never know-"

#### Travis:

Wait, what?

### **Griffin**:

"I don't know. I've never known anyone outside from out of the country except for Russians and Canadians, and I don't notice when it happens until my friends start to talk in their English accents, which, frankly, are horrid sounding most of the time, and then I am not too sure what to do.

# **Griffin**:

Feeling.

# **Griffin**:

Mm-hmm (affirmative).

# Travis:

### **Griffin**:

Or the person who, um, uh, the person who goes to London with their rich parents, uh, on a, like, summer break, and then comes back and then exclusively talks with a British accent? Which is worse?

# **Travis**:

Which one's worse?

Yeah.

### **Travis**:

Oh, god. It's, it's, like, so tiny a difference. Both are so terrible.

# Justin:

### **Griffin**:

# Travis:

I can, I can only do French Canadian trapper.

# **Griffin**:

Give me it.

### **Travis**:

I got French Canadian fur- and I can only say the sentence: (French Canadian accent) I am a French Canadian trapper.

### **Griffin**:

Okay.

# Travis:

And that's the only thing I can say.

# Griffin:

Well, that's- well, that'll be the only thing you say for the rest of the podcast. Like, Justin broke out his Baron- his Baron Harkonnen.

# Justin:

Can it be the last thing he says?

# **Griffin**:

Yes.

### **Justin**:

That would be ideal.

# **Griffin**:

Justin can bust out his Baron Harkonnen. I will do that drunk Beatle accent that I was doing a few, a few minutes ago, and then Travis just says that one-

# Justin:

Shit, that was a good one.

Yeah.

### **Justin**:

Yeah.

### **Griffin**:

Travis just says that one thing, over and over again.

### Travis:

Um, so before we, uh, take a trip, um I would like to throw out, uh, Justin made the mistake of giving me time, uh, between the time we were going to record the episode, and the time when we actually did. So I played a game with our listeners, and I asked them for words that they would like to hear on the show.

### **Griffin**:

You made a Mad Libs.

### Travis:

And I arranged those words into a short story that I would like Griffin to read now.

# **Griffin**:

Okay. So what I'm looking at is a Mad Lib that-

# **Travis**:

Uh-huh.

# Justin:

(laughs)

# **Griffin**:

It's a Mad Lib. Like, that's not- let's not split hairs.

Yes.

#### Justin:

Sometimes we make bits on this show because I think it'll be- they'll be funny, and then sometimes we make bits on the show to antagonize each other. For instance, monthly observances? I hate that bit.

### Travis:

(laughs)

### Justin:

I think Travis kind of does, too. Griffin inflicts it upon us every fucking month.

#### Travis:

This was actually Justin's punishment for not being ready to record the call when he was supposed to.

#### Justin:

That-

### Travis:

So now he has to hear this Mad Lib.

### Justin:

I had something really important come up.

#### **Griffin**:

What, what was it?

#### **Justin**:

It was a cliffhanger.

#### Travis:

What? Excuse me?

It was a cliffhanger. I couldn't just not watch the second half.

#### Travis:

Oh what show, Justin?

### **Justin**:

I forget.

### Travis:

Mm-hmm (affirmative). Was it Toddlers and Tiaras?

### Justin:

Yeah.

# Travis:

Okay.

**Justin:** Eden Wood (laughs) lost her, lost her foot in a logging accident (laughing) and they didn't know if she'd be able to perform.

### **Griffin**:

"Uh, this is the epic and moist fable of Bumsy Clumhole and the marshmallow debacle." Why am I doing this?

# Justin:

(laughing forcefully)

### Travis:

Read away.

### Justin:

Don't stop now.

### Griffin:

Travis, this is making me hate you and our listeners who sent this shit in.

### **Travis**:

Do it.

### **Griffin**:

"One fine and scrumptious day, Bumsy was hanging out with his funkaclicious friend, Batman. They were running late for the big race, the thick freakness..."

Justin:

(laughs)

# **Griffin**:

"They had been watching the clock when suddenly everything got all timey-wimey, wibbly-wobbly." There's the *Doctor Who* thing. "So they- they lept onto their Pegasus, Celestia Sprinkles, and sprang into action, only stopping to get a fish taco on the way. 'Slow down,' yelled Batman. 'This is chafing my turgid front-butt and giving me the vicious thoughts.'

"Oh, hogwash,' yelled Bumsy. 'Stop being persnickety. This is funkalicious.'

"Incredible,' sighed Batman. But sadly the whole thing was a boondoggle. Bumsy died, and Batman was left as the only living boy in New York."

That was the end of it, and we will never do that to you again. (boys laughing) And I promise you that.

I wrote a book in second grade called Grant Andrews, Kid Cop, that reads-

# Travis:

Uh-huh.

# **Griffin**:

That reads better than that thing that you made.

# **Justin**:

(laughs) Why did you do that to him? Why is that you were trying to punish me, but Griffin ends up catching the brunt of it?

Because it was humiliating. I said words in there that I would never say. Funkalicious? You realize that every word I say is like a precious treasure, right?

## **Travis**:

Yes.

## Griffin:

And you just, you just tarnished my streak.

### Justin:

Precious treasures. Uh, let's- there's only one way I can wash this taste from- (laughs) I liked it. I, I'm 30, though. I think old people jokes are funny. Let's go to the Money Zone.

### **Griffin**:

Let's go to the suicide zone.

#### **Justin**:

And then the Money Zone.

(theme music plays)

#### Justin:

"Hey, Katie. Happy birthday, lady. Thank you for being you. Your boyfriend Charlie, you introduced to a lot of great stuff, like *My Brother, My Brother, and Me*, an advice show for the modern era, and *Katamari Damacy*. And now he's returning the favor by saying, 'Hey, happy birthday.'"

### **Griffin**:

You know, there's, there's so much of a connection between those two things, don't you guys think?

### **Justin**:

Between My Brother, My Brother and Me and Katamari Damacy?

Yeah. Because in *Katamari Damacy*, you roll a ball and you pick up things to make the ball bigger.

## **Travis**:

Uh-huh.

## **Griffin**:

And then, and in *My Brother, My Brother, and Me*, you roll your ears through our words, and it makes your heart bigger.

## Justin:

Wow. Yeah, right. That's haunting.

## Griffin:

Until your heart gets too big for your chest, and then you die- you die from it. It explodes.

### Travis:

Like Seabiscuit.

## **Griffin**:

That's my favorite trap from the *Saw* movies.

### Justin:

Hey, Charlene, your boyfriend, Adam, is Gabor- is having his birthday today. And you, you, uh-

## Griffin:

You fucked up twice really bad so far.

### Justin:

Let me try this. Let me try this.

### **Griffin**:

Let's take it apart. The first goof was that you called her (hard  $\CH''$  sound) Charlene-

Uh-huh.

# **Griffin**:

And not (soft "CH" sound) Charlene.

## **Justin**:

Okay. That was my bad.

## **Griffin**:

You know, you know who my favorite Hollywood actress is? Char-lize Theron.

## **Travis**:

Mm-hmm (affirmative).

### Justin:

Hey, um, Adam, happy birthday and anniversary from (hard "CH" sound) Charlene. Uh, both are within about-

## **Travis**:

It's a soft- it's a soft "shh."

### Travis and Justin:

(slowly) Charlene...

### Griffin:

I mean, I'll, I'll tell you the other problem is that, um, you were stuttering earlier, and you said, "Adam is Gabor" and that sounds like-

### Justin:

No, Adam is- Adam is Bieber.

### **Griffin**:

Adam is Bieber.

### Justin:

Adam Gabor, it's their anniversary and his birthday. They're within about three days of each other. He likes many things, but loves bumblebees.

### Travis:

I'm gonna call Charlene out on something here. What do you mean, "It's *about* three days apart"? Like, it fluctuates?

### Justin:

Well, his birthday-

### **Griffin**:

Well, the leap year.

### Justin:

Yeah. Right. Exactly.

### **Travis**:

Shouldn't it be exactly three days apart?

### Travis:

Why are you acting like this?

### **Griffin**:

You know that every day is, like, incrementally, like microscopically longer than the last day, you know what right? Like, days are getting longer.

#### Justin:

Yeah. She's actually far more accurate than you are.

### Travis:

Oh.

#### Justin:

Because they started dating at some point during the day, and he was born at some point during the night.

### Travis:

Oh, so she's got it, like, down to the second.

## Justin:

She knows exactly the second. She just didn't want to bore you with the details. But hey, happy birthday and anniversary. If you'd like me to mispronounce your name, you can go to maximumfun.org/jumobotron and, uh, get a message up there. But, uh, thank you to all of you, and happy birthday or anniversary, as the case may be.

## **Griffin**:

Um, I'd like to come off it with a Yahoo answer, if we can.

### Justin:

Okay. Gladly.

### Griffin:

Um, this one, this one's actually old. I've been holding on to this one. I've had this arrow in my quiver for a long time, it was sent in by Jakob Locker. Thank you, Jakob. It's by Yahoo Answers user James, who asks, "How can I make myself into a human peanut butter and jelly sandwich?"

## **Justin**:

(wheezes, laughs)

### Travis:

Uh-huh. Yes, go on.

### **Griffin**:

Okay. Okay. Okay. Okay. "I like making messes (boys laughing) and I want to really do this. The first thing I want to do is get covered in a peanut butter-type of mixture, and then a jelly type of mixture and have, like, uh, some giant bread made of smaller bread. And also, when I get the peanut butter mixture and j- j- jelly mixture poured on me, she..."

### Justin:

Oh, no.

Stop.

# **Griffin**:

"I lay on the bread, and get it dumped on me. Or just stand up, and have it poured on me. It's your vote. And last but not least, how could I make, like, a maybe runny, liquidy peanut butter mix and runny, liquidy jelly mix?" That, that guys, that, that was all one, one sentence.

## **Travis**:

Oh, no.

# **Griffin**:

"Tell me what you guys think, and how could I- how I could make a mess with this stuff. And I forgot to say that at the end, after I get the mixtures poured on me, I'm gonna get two giant pieces of bread, cover it with regular PB&J, cover myself up, and maybe roll around in it. Unleash the ideas and the creativeness. Hahaha. This will be so much fun and feel awesome!"

## Travis:

I'm right in thinking that there's an underlying, and all the while, "I'm going to be jerking it so right."

## **Griffin**:

"I'm gonna jerk it, uh, in this runny, liquidy jelly-type mixture."

## Travis:

"Oh, and BT-dubs, I'm just gonna be jerking it."

# Justin:

Danny is just one flag away from that trip to Universal Studios. He's made it through the Gak fountain, made it through the carwash. Now he's just gotta get this one last flag from a giant peanut butter and jelly sandwich. And- oh my god, is he masturbating?

# **Griffin**:

Oh my god.

## Justin:

He's fiendishly masturbating, Mark.

## **Travis**:

He's just so excited about that Casio keyboard.

## Justin:

That Casio keyboard. That-

## **Griffin**:

He is-

### Justin:

That-

### **Griffin**:

"He has found the flag. He is using the flag as some sort of jerk-it sheath. I'm Mark Summers, and I quit television forever, because I am yucked."

### Travis:

"I am retired. I have- now have obsessive compulsive disorder."

## **Griffin**:

"I now, because of this child's lewd act, (laughing) I am leaving the entertainment business."

### Travis:

And that completes our Mark Summers origin story (laughing).

## **Griffin**:

Those flags- those flags are for- those are roller skate vouchers, not jerk-it sheets.

## **Justin**:

Sir.

## **Griffin**:

Sir.

### Justin:

Sir.

## **Griffin**:

Pardon.

## Justin:

Good day.

## **Griffin**:

You do- you win nothing. Hey, Mark. You want to watch?

## Travis:

Hey, Mark?

# **Griffin**:

I double dare you.

## Justin:

(laughs hard)

## Travis:

I'm, I'm gonna ask a- (laughing) I'm gonna ask a question-

## Griffin:

Mark, you up for a physical challenge?

# Travis:

... That maybe-

## Griffin:

Come over here and watch.

## Travis:

I, I might be hoping for too much here when I ask this question: to what purpose?

### **Griffin**:

He likes to make messes.

### Justin:

He likes to-

### Travis:

Like, that's it? Like, he's gonna do this in the privacy of his own home?

### Justin:

He likes to get super sloppy.

### Travis:

Like, he's just gonna be in his parents basement making himself a giant PB & J?

#### **Griffin**:

I think it's gonna take him a while. I think it's gonna take him a long time. But not too long, because if he wants to make a giant bread out of tiny breads, those are gonna get kind of- kind of moldy after- yeah.

### Travis:

Oh, so you're afraid of this getting gross in some way?

#### Griffin:

Right. I'm saying that he's got a really small window to execute this idea.

#### Justin:

If he wants to do this taste- if he wants to do this tastefully, he's gotta think about it.

### Travis:

You know what's funny? If he does this at home by himself, it's disgusting. If he does it in front of a crowd, it's modern art.

Yeah. Well, that's the idea, right? He wants to unleash the ideas and creativeness. And as a side effect, it's gonna be so much fun. And it's gonna feel awesome. And, like, I don't deny that. Can you guys imagine how good that would feel?

### Travis:

Well, as long as he doesn't use chunky, because that shit gets everywhere.

### **Griffin**:

Yeah, that would be kind of abrasive on your skin. You would have to go Jif smooth.

### Justin:

Yeah.

### Travis:

Oh, yeah. Totally.

### **Griffin**:

Or-

### Travis:

Choosy moms choose Jif for their man-sized PB & J's.

### **Griffin**:

Can- can I change my either legal name or karaoke name to Jif Smooth? (laughing).

### Justin:

(laughs) I think you could go to Jif Smooth (laughs).

"Who b- who borrowed your car?"

"I loaned it to Jif Smooth."

"Ah, that was a misstep."

"Yeah, I should've known."

### **Griffin**:

Yeah, because he likes to make messes.

#### Travis:

He's a messy, messy boy, Jif Smooth. Um- when he says, like, a jelly-type mixture, does he mean jelly? I believe jelly is a jelly-type mixture.

### **Griffin**:

It has to be some sort of gelatinous, plasmotic substance. Something that oscillates between liquid and solid.

### Travis:

Oh, like lava?

### Griffin:

Like a lava, yeah, which would be great.

### Travis:

Uh-huh (affirmative).

#### Griffin:

It's like, hey, why don't we don't this. I'll wrap you up in a blanket or an afghan, and I'll say you're a burrito, and I'll throw you in a volcano so that we never have to think about you again.

#### Justin:

That sounds great.

#### Griffin:

That sounds like a real tasty mix.

#### Justin:

Will this guy eat it later?

Yeah, that's- that's what I don't understand. Like, is he doing this, and then he's gonna be like, "Now, somebody eat me"?

# **Griffin**:

No, someone-

## Travis:

Or is he just, like, doing it, and then he's gonna be done, and then he's gonna shower and go to work at the bar after?

### **Griffin**:

I don't think he's gonna shower. I think he's gonna go to work still covered in, you know, placenta, or whatever he ends up doing.

### Travis:

"Jeff, you've been trying to get fired for a long time. Um-"

### Justin:

That's the most-

## Travis:

"... I feel like you've finally crossed the line."

### **Justin**:

... Outlandish plan yet.

### Griffin:

Again, or, he's gonna do this in the middle of his local park, and people will be like, "This is- this is Jif Smooth's magnum opus."

## Justin:

Or he'll do it- he'll do it on NBC late nights and have Guy Fieri give him \$100,000 on *Minute to Win It.* 

## Travis:

Yeah.

Mm-hmm (affirmative).

## Justin:

That's basically what *Minute to Win It* is, just make a giant peanut butter, I bet.

## **Griffin**:

You have 60 seconds to get *so* nasty.

## Justin:

(laughs) If you can cover yourself in peanut butter, then steal my head visor, I'm going to give you \$100,000. Let's play (very muffled) *Minute to Win It*. (normally) I have not seen the show.

### **Griffin**:

(laughs).

## Travis:

Oh, he's got peanut butter stuck in his mouth.

### Justin:

Why are you licking Jiff smooth off?

### **Griffin**:

Can we create a reality- a reality TV show that's, like, sort of *Most Dangerous Game*. Like, or *Hard Target* is a better example where it's just, you have to find Guy Fieri and take his head wear. (laughing) Make it your own.

## Travis:

Like a Lord of the Flies kind of thing?

## **Griffin**:

Mm-hmm (affirmative).

## Justin:

Yeah. It would be sort of like *The Amazing Race* mixed with *Hostel*.

### **Griffin**:

Yeah.

## **Travis**:

Okay.

### Justin:

Because, because you'll have to take his head, too.

## Travis:

You gotta take the head of Guy Fieri. "Bring me the head of Guy Fieri."

## **Griffin**:

Well, all his life- life power is bound to his head visor.

## Travis:

Right.

### **Griffin**:

I mean, that's- that's- he- that is the, sort of the magical root that animates his golem- his golem-esque body.

### Travis:

Guy Fieri is a golem.

### **Griffin**:

Yeah, that's what I'm saying.

### Travis:

Hey, you know what? You guys can laugh it up. The man makes a hell of a Tex-Mex salad plate.

## **Griffin**:

(laughs) That man makes a great Chinese.

(laughing, claps)

## Griffin:

Yum. Yum, yum, yum.

### Justin:

Yum. Yum, yum, give me some.

"Uh, for the last year-and-a-half, a friend of our family has been staying on our couch Monday through Friday. He works in Manhattan during the week, returns to his family upstate on the weekend. My question is, how do I let him know he needs to find another couch without being the asshole who stops him from providing for his family?" Bewildered in Brooklyn. Wow, that's a toughie.

### Travis:

You're-

### Justin:

Hey, I do wanna- want to alleviate- I want to alleviate your guilt, though. You are not, like- you are not stopping him from providing. He's not providing for his family, he's living on your couch. You're providing for his family. You're, you're meeting him halfway here.

### Travis:

A year and a half?

### **Griffin**:

It's no big deal. Just like-

#### Travis:

No, that seems like the kind of thing you do where you say, "Hey, I need to do this until I can find other arrangements."

### **Griffin**:

It's just 500 days of d- Devin. Just 500 of Devin just crashing on the couch.

This is fucking You, Me, and Dupree shit.

## Justin:

Hey, when people, uh, go to look for a place to live, they do that. Like, that's just not how people do. Like, we get places to live in.

### Travis:

Yeah.

## Griffin:

We find a place to live, and then live in it every day of the week.

## Travis:

Is he- is he in any way, like, compensating you, or like paying you for bills, or rent, or something?

## **Griffin**:

You-

## **Justin**:

Listen, I want you to know something, friend of the show. You- you should have- like, guilt should not even be in your- like, you could not be further from the asshole. You could set the couch on fire and throw it out a window while he's sleeping on it. You still would not be the bad guy in this situation.

### Travis:

Yeah. I think all you have to do is say, "Listen, um, it's been a while now, and I'd, I'd like to know what the permanent solution is."

## **Justin**:

A while? It's a been a goddamn year and a half! It's been all the whiles!

## **Travis**:

"Seasons have changed, winter has melted into spring."

## Justin:

"A young man-"

### Travis:

"Now it's time for you to get the fuck out."

### Justin:

"A young man's fancy has turned a fucking leaf. Get out of my house."

## **Griffin**:

If this living situation were a human being, it would be like walking and almost talking now.

### Justin:

Yeah. Yeah. It is talking. It's saying, "Get the fuck out of my house."

## **Griffin**:

Get the fucking- fucking leave. I want to sit on that couch.

### Justin:

It smells like you forever.

### **Griffin**:

It smells like you sleep. It smells like you when you're asleep! I hate it here.

## Justin:

(laughs) "I'm moving. You can stay if you want."

### **Travis**:

How is your friend comfortable with this living arrangement? Like, what-

### Justin:

It's- well, it's a great couch.

### **Travis**:

[crosstalk 00:37:19] I don't want to pass judgment here, but I can't imagine living on someone's couch for five days a week, for a year and a half, and not feeling like an asshole myself.

I, I have this theory that living in New York is kind of like living in an awesome but also post-apocalyptic world where it's like, "We just gotta survive, man. We gotta survive, so we can go- get to the good parts."

### Travis:

Oh, so it's like catch as catch can. Like, you find a closet to sleep in and you sleep there.

## **Griffin**:

I saw this video of this gentleman who was living in an apartment that was 63 square feet. 63 square feet! His bed turned into a couch with the use of special panels, and he kept his microwave in his clothing closet!

### Travis:

### Justin:

He's gonna be-

### **Griffin**:

#### Justin:

### **Griffin**:

#### **Justin**:

But think about what a great scene that's gonna be when they do his True Hollywood story, because he turns into a famous actor.

#### Griffin:

He was totally happy about it. He was like, "Oh, I prefer- you know, I just, I go out do all my business in the city, and then I come home, I just sleep in here." And it's like, yeah, but that's what, like, prisoners say. In jail.

I live in this iron maiden. Um, it's rent controlled, so that's pretty night. It's \$850 a month, uh, no bills included.

## **Griffin**:

It's, uh, it gets pretty cold. There's- it gets pretty cold in the winter, but my four friends just come in and sleep on top of me.

## Justin:

Make a human peanut butter and jelly sandwich.

### **Griffin**:

Yeah. You know what he paid for that apartment? Like 800 bucks.

## Travis:

Yeah.

## **Griffin**:

That's not okay, guys.

## Travis:

So, yeah. Kick your friend out.

### Justin:

Kick him the fuck- and, and you know what? You know what? Seriously, not even a joke. I know this would be an awkward moment for you. Take us over there. Pick us up, carry us over there. Come on, pick up the computer, lug us over there. Hey, friend. Hey, listen. These times... No, you know what? I'm not even gonna do the nice thing, because it's been a year and a half. Time to go.

## **Griffin**:

Yeah. Time to- time to fish. What is it? Fish and friends keep for three days?

## **Justin**:

Yep.

What is the- what's the thing? Fish and friends?

## Travis:

Yeah. You wrap up your friends in some newspaper, and you toss them to people, and then you throw them out the door.

### Justin:

Yep.

## **Griffin**:

It's-

## Justin:

It's [inaudible 00:39:32].

## **Griffin**:

It's company and poultry stink after a week. That's what, um, that's what the quotables says, that book of quotables.

### Justin:

Please. Please go.

### Travis:

Yeah.

### Justin:

I- now I'm talking to Griffin, also.

## **Griffin**:

Oh, sorry.

### Justin:

Both the, the friend- friend, you've been sleeping on the couch. We've all had some good times. There was the one time when Jeff brought over the whisky and you guys got really drunk. It was great and everybody- it's time

to go. It's gone far enough. It's time to leave. It's time to go. (laughs softly) Are you going? You're still here.

#### Travis:

Are you out now?

### Justin:

Pick up-

### **Griffin**:

Is he gone?

### Justin:

Is he gone? Hey, pick up a bag, put your things in the bag- that's why you don't have many things, because you're sleeping on the couch, and just go.

### Travis:

Uh-huh (affirmative).

#### Justin:

Go find an apartment.

### **Griffin**:

Find a bag that's big enough for your things, collect them, and skedaddle.

#### Justin:

Skedaddle!

#### Travis:

Just GTFO, come on.

#### **Griffin**:

It is, let me check my watch, bounce o'clock!

#### **Justin**:

(wheezes, laughs) Time to bounce. Why are you still here? Get out.

No, we can hear you. You just pretended to walk away and then froze.

### **Griffin**:

We heard you open the door and then shut it.

### Travis:

We can see you.

## **Griffin**:

It is dip time. It is time to dip. Go.

## Justin:

You're still here!

### Travis:

Go. Go.

## Justin:

Close the door behind you. Don't come back.

### Travis:

Now change the locks so hard.

# Justin:

Change the locks, quick.

### **Griffin**:

Change his locks.

### Justin:

Quick.

## Griffin:

Board it up.

### Justin:

Get a 2x4 and board it up. Board it up. Now listen, you've got to leave through the window. You can never come back. They can never see you again. You're a ghost now. You hear me? You're a ghost. Why are you still here? You need to go, too.

#### **Travis**:

You gotta go into a gas station bathroom-

#### Justin:

This is our house.

#### Travis:

And cut and dye your hair, shave off your beard, uh, change your clothes-

#### Justin:

And never come back.

#### Travis:

... Change your name.

#### **Justin**:

Now, quick. Wait, wait. Come back, come back. Turn us around towards the TV and put on Steve Wilkos. (laughing) Now, go.

#### Griffin:

(laughs loudly)

#### Justin:

This is our house now. Get out.

#### **Griffin**:

Man, this couch sure is comfortable. I get why you slept on it for 500 days.

#### Justin:

Oh, man. Free apartment?

Hey, you got any [inaudible 00:41:34]?

### Travis:

It's all right. We'll find them later. We'll walk around.

## **Griffin**:

Where the [inaudible 00:41:39] at? Gonna dip 'em.

### Justin:

We're gonna evolve. Um, so this- this is our pad now.

### Travis:

It's pretty nice.

### Justin:

Yeah, it's nice. I like it. Especially the couch.

### **Griffin**:

I'm gonna need you guys to leave because I have a, I have a girl coming over.

### Travis:

Oh, okay.

### Justin:

Oh, yeah. No worries. No sweat.

## Griffin:

She's on a- she's on a MacBook Pro.

### Justin:

It's cas- it's casual.

"Uh, I recently started dating this amazing girl. We only have been dating for the past three weeks, but I can tell there is a true connection. The problem is we're both in our mid-20's back living at home, trying to get back on our feet. Neither of us are that happy with our current living situation. ## **Griffin**:

Yeah.

## Travis:

You know what I mean?

## Justin:

Yeah. I think it's really early, dog. I'd wait. I'm sure you're cool-

## Travis:

But I appreciate the sentiment. I, I think it's beautiful that you are, are thinking about it now.

## **Griffin**:

I'm happy that you're so in love.

## **Travis**:

Yeah.

## **Justin**:

It's also gonna put a lot of pressure on your relationship early that they may not want.

## **Griffin**:

Yeah, that's true. But at the same time, maybe you should just do it.

## Travis:

But here's the other thing-

### Justin:

Woah.

## Travis:

Three weeks in, you'll have to talk about money, and who's gonna pay for what bills, and-

## **Griffin**:

Oh, love will find a way, Travis.

## Travis:

No.

## **Griffin**:

What happened to your heart? Love will find a way. What did Vin Diesel say, that you either have to get busy living together, or get busy dying together.

## Travis:

Yeah.

## **Griffin**:

I think it's time. I think- you know what? I think you're one week late.

## Justin:

Ooh.

## **Griffin**:

## Justin:

## **Travis**:

Yep.

## Justin:

## Travis:

## Justin:

## Travis:
