Travis:

Uh-huh.

Justin:

... and watch Ms. Jane Lynch, uh, do her thing tonight on the Emmy stage to honor some of my favorite programs of the year.

Griffin:

Who do you like? Justin, who do you favor this year?

Justin:

Glee. Obviously...

Griffin:

Glee.

Justin:

I got Glee...

Travis:

Like, across the board?

Justin:

I got Glee fever over here, Gleever. I've got it.

Griffin:

Who's...

Justin:

I've got Gleever.

Griffin:

Who's taking home that tiny golden angel?

Justin:

That little golden angel is going in the hands of the talented Ms. Lea Michele for her portrayal of a role of sing... sing girl from Glee.

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

Sling...

Travis:

Uh-huh.

Justin:

It's sing, sing girl from Glee.

Griffin:

Jessica Singstar.

Justin:

Jessica Singstar, the talented, upstart, half Jewish, half singer, talent powerhouse known as Glea Michele.

Travis:

Now Justin, let me ask you this.

Justin:

Yes?

Travis:

Who's your pick for outstanding sound mixing for non-fiction in programming?

Justin:

Uh, that is gonna go to the one and only Ken Burns for his documentary on Glee.

Travis:

Ah, I see. Okay.

Justin:

My name is Justin McElroy. I'm your oldest brother and I have Gleever.

Travis:

Uh, I'm Travis McElroy and I think that that Ken Burns documentary would be called, uh, The Gay the Earth Stood Still.

Justin:

[laughs]

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

And I'm Griffin.

Justin:

[laughs] How's your Gleever right now?

Griffin:

Uh, it's low. I'd be, uh, I had a... I took a, uh, a pretty intense regime of antibiotics.

Justin:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

Uh, that really, really dried me up inside and out, uh, but I've finally beaten... I've beaten the Glee.

Justin:

You kicked it?

Griffin:

I kicked the Glee. It was tough, tough stuff for a while. Uh, now I hope...

Travis:

Yeah.

Griffin:

... but now I'm just hooked on Modern Family.

Travis:

Oh, yeah?

Griffin:

Oh, the so... the scenarios that they get into on that show.

Justin:

Which one on that show is the robot? I always forget.

Griffin:

The little... The child.

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

The child is-

Travis:

Small wonders to you.

Griffin:

Yeah, they had...

Justin:

Small wonders...

Griffin:

... to replace her because her, um, her robot batteries ran out. She died...

Travis:

Really?

Griffin:

She died. Yeah, she died from it.

Justin:

Don't you think that Modern Family, if you're gonna use a name like that, you got to have one of the kids as an android?

Travis:

I mean, one's like a mutant. Like...

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

... a nuclear, you know, kind of thing.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

Oh, and then you call it Nuclear Family.

Griffin:

There you go. Hey ABC, you're welcome.

Justin:

Whoa. Hey. TM. TM. C with a circle. This is of course an advice show for the modern era. Uh, so let's dip into the questions that we've been sent by you, the listening public.

"This morning I woke up from a fun filled Friday night and realized I felt like garbage since I forgot to take care of the Ibuprofen before bed and the two early in the morning trick." You're welcome, by the way, everybody. "Uh, so my question's this, when I wake up feeling nauseous and a bit dizzy, not that hangover headache style which, question within a question, is a splitting headache required for it to be considered a hangover?" No. "But just feeling disoriented and poopy, am I still technically drunk?"

And that's from "Oh God, I Hope I Don't Blow a .08 which says to me this caller was drunk driving which of course we do not endorse.

Travis:

No, no, because when you wake up in the morning, there's no way you're still drunk. Like...

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

... if you were still drunk, you wouldn't feel poopy and terrible. You'd feel awesome.

Griffin:

You'd feel great.

Justin:

If... Yeah, right. Exactly. Exactly. It's fading fast.

Travis:

I think it's one of those things like a crazy person never... it like, if you think you might be crazy, you're not crazy.

Justin:

Mm-hmm..

Travis:

Like if you have the coherence to go, "Oh, I feel bad and crappy. Maybe I'm drunk." Then you're not drunk.

Justin:

Yeah. What you have is a... it's called a loss of sense of wellbeing. It's one of the symptoms of hangovers which, you know, don't require headaches. It can manifest in lots of people different ways. Some people, uh, get a, you know, headaches. Some people get nausea. Some people get cranky, uh...

Griffin:

Some people get just really randy.

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

Yeah, some people get, like, horny.

Griffin:

Just real...

Travis:

Just, grr, I want to light it up.

Griffin:

...just horned out.

Justin:

Um, uh, the very first time I got drunk on, on Mountain Dew Code Red and vodka, I woke up the next morning just happy to be alive.

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

Are you fucking kidding me?

Justin:

What?

Griffin:

That's the first thing you got drunk on was Code Red and vodka?

Justin:

Yeah, that was a fun puke.

Griffin:

What, did you throw some combos into that cocktail?

Travis:

[laughs] It was spicy tortilla and salsa.

Griffin:

What kind of cheesy snack cracker were you pounding?

Justin:

You know what's funny about that time? The every next night I ate a pound hamburger at Fuddruckers and I puked then too. So I puked...

Griffin:

Oh, god.

Justin:

I puked two nights in a row. Neither from illness.

Travis:

That weekend is your Everest.

Justin:

How's your lifestyle? Not good? Sounds pretty bad. Um, did this person ask for advice and I missed it?

Travis:

No, he's asking the question, is he still technically drunk? If I think what he's asking is, like, is he capable to function the next morning and do things like drive to the store and...

Griffin:

No.

Travis:

... drive home from the party.

Griffin:

No, no, no. I was watching this... I was watching this Dateline where they said if you're like... if you're like mega sleepy. If you're like the sleepest...

Travis:

Yeah.

Griffin:

It's the same as being drunk. Again you shouldn't...

Travis:

Here's the thing people...

Griffin:

Shouldn't drive a car.

Travis:

Being drunk... Being drunk isn't the only thing that stops you from being a good driver. Like I can't stress that enough. If you're super tired or meat drunk or...

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

... like you're—

Griffin:

Pot high.

Travis:

... watching Netflix on your laptop or pot high. Don't drive pot high. I can't stress that enough.

Griffin:

No. 'Cause you'll get giggles. But like...

Justin:

Oh, yeah.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Rely on your pot chauffeur. Always...

Griffin:

Yes.

Justin:

... arrange for a pot chauffeur before.

Griffin:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

Never forget. **Griffin:**

Giles. Giles, I need you.

Travis:

Giles?

Justin:

Giles.

Griffin:

Giles, take me to the Taco Bell.

Travis:

Here's I think that what you should plan on is if you pass out at the party, uh, general MO should be you wake up in the morning and you watch, uh, some kind of bro movie or terrible movie and have an, uh, some eggs and just kind of lay on the couch for hours.

Justin:

Eggs are good, they have... Eggs are good, they have selenium in 'em.

Travis:

Uh-huh.

Justin:

Your body is craving that.

Griffin:

Travis can yo—

Travis:

And, and also bacon if you got queezy tummy.

Griffin:

Can you give us...

Travis:

Yes.

Griffin:

... a bro movie that like a per- just an example of a bro movie or bad movie—

Travis:

Hangover.

Griffin:

Okay. A little on the nose but...

Travis:

I mean, but it's perfect. You can watch, uh, Short Circuit. Um, anything with Steve Guttenberg is gonna be great.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

Uh, anything with Tim Robbins from the '80s.

Griffin:

Guttenberg has plenty of selenium in him and that's a good—

Justin:

[laughs] Yeah. That's what your body craves.

Griffin:

Your body craves the Gut at that point in time.

Travis:

[laughs] Ooo, Idiocracy is a great movie to wait... to watch when you're hungover.

Griffin:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

My body craves Guttenberg.

Griffin:

Mm-hmm.

Travis:

Gotta get the Gu.

Justin:

This is... This is Gatorade G3 and the, the first two G's are Gatorade and the third one is Guttenberg.

Travis:

Can we jump back to the '80s when he was real popular so I can use the phrase "Get the Gut" more?

Griffin:

Yeah. Get that Gut.

Justin:

Get the Gut.

Griffin:

When can I get that Gut?

Justin:

Like, you guys saw him in Veronica Mars. He was great. He still got all the old...

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

... old pizazzal.

Travis: Oh, his episode of Party Down is one of the funniest things I've ever seen.

Griffin:

Oh, just amazing. Um...

Justin:

He's great. He's a talent. So I guess if you're... I don't know if you were still drunk when you wrote this email but if you're still drunk, uh, I'm—

Travis:

Then you have a serious problem.

Justin:

You're a mailman, probably.

Griffin:

The prob... I mean, he... I'm pretty sure he was drunk. I'm looking at the... I'm looking at his, um, uh, his grammar here. I'm looking at his... he's got parenthesis inside of brackets, inside of those like curly brackets. I don't know what those are actually called. Uh, there's...

Justin:

Question marks.

Griffin:

... a lot of things... a lot of things happening in the typography here that, that...

Travis:

What you can do is if, if you wake up and you're still drunk, you do want my friend Dan did in college which is, uh, decide it's not safe to drive home and walk home and take a nap under a tree.

Griffin:

Hey, that's what trees are for, you dummy.

Travis:

Yeah. They're right there.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Shield you from the moonlight.

Griffin:

They're like, hey, temporary houses for drunk people.

Justin:

[laughs] "My girl—" And elves. And drunk elves.

Griffin:

Uh-huh.

Justin:

"Uh, my girlfriend and I broke up about eight weeks ago and even though I instigated it, it was still a very tough breakup. I'm feeling better now."

Travis:

Good.

Justin:

"But I'm not quite back to my normal self. Last week, a cute girl gave me her number and we'll be going on a date soon. However..."

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

... I'm feeling nervous about the date. I'm not sure I'm fully over my ex and ready to go on a date with a new girl. How will I know when I'm ready and is there anything wrong with going on a date when I'm not sure I'm ready?"
That's from ready or rebounding.

Travis:

Mm. Hmm.

Justin:

I think that's how you... Isn't that how you find out you're ready?

Griffin:

Yeah. Yeah. You've come to the right place. That's, that is how you find out. Like you can't... You're so inside your own head right now. I'm assuming that this was a long relationship that he was in. Uh, if he's still having that tough time with it eight...

Justin:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

... weeks later.

Travis:

And at the very least, it sounds like it was important.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

You know?

Griffin:

Um, so you may be ready, you may not be ready but the only way to really tell is to... is to go on a date and there's nothing wrong with that. Um, you, you should probably be kind of upfront about the fact that you just got out of a long relationship depending on how comfortable you are with...

Justin:

Yeah, don't, like, bring it... Like, don't... That's not an opener...

Griffin:

Uh, by the way...

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

Yeah.

Travis:

[laughs] Uh, I should tell you. Uh, and yet then you also don't want to linger on that point.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

You wanna, like, drop that knowledge and then move on.

Griffin:

Just like, "Hey, quick info."

Justin:

I wouldn't... Yeah, I wouldn't stress too much about a date. You know what I mean? Like, I think you could debate whether or not you're ready to get back into a long term relationship or what have you.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

But the, you know, it's a date. Just go on it and, you know, when I was, uh, when I was young... a young man and I... and I still do this to a certain extent. When you're sick, you spend whole days in bed.

Griffin:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

You know, eating your ramen or your Noodle-O's or what have you and when you think you're starting to feel better, I always used to do, I would call it puttering around. You know...

Griffin:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

... you put on some sweatpants. You just kind of move around the house a little bit. Get your bearings. If, if you...

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

... stay there in bed even when you're not sick, you're gonna feel like it and loneliness and being single and getting over a breakup is a lot the same way. Until you kind of kick that in gear and force your body and mind into that, like... It's not gonna happen to you. You've got to bring a little bit of momentum to that change.

Griffin:

And that's a really great analogy because while you're puttering around in the love sphere, you're gonna still be wearing your sweatpants and you're not gonna be super good at pretty much anything but you'll... one of these days, you'll shake off your contagion. You'll shake off the bonds of your plague and you'll...

Justin:

Right.

Griffin:

... leave your house and you'll fall in love again. You'll have the sunshine on your skin. Feel the rain on your skin.

Justin:

Maybe this girl is that big bite of the recovery sandwich that you need to take.

Travis:

Mm.

Griffin:

Right.

Travis:

Yeah.

Griffin:

Big chomp of it. Have I used that term on this show before? That term was so important to me in my formative years.

Travis:

I don't think we've ever mentioned the recovery sandwich.

Griffin:

Hmm.

Justin:

Um, how did the recovery... Can you explain me the recovery sandwich a little bit Griffin?

Griffin:

Uh, I mean, anytime one of us would get hurt by a woman kind which was frequent. Uh, the others would sort of rally around. I'm pretty sure you incepted the phrase, Justin and, uh...

Justin:

You know what? I actually think my dear friend Tommy Redd incepted the recovery sandwich.

Travis:

Oh, yeah?

Justin:

Yeah, he sent me the first one I believe. Um, but you just take a big bite of that recovery sandwich. Just get on... Just get on with it.

Griffin:

You got to take measures.

Justin:

Yup.

Travis:

Yeah.

Griffin:

Justin:

Just propose.

Griffin:

One...

Travis:

Now I will say but the one caveat I will have is that sometimes, uh, in that reboundy phase coming out of a serious breakup, uh, if it was a long term serious relationship you came out of, you're gonna wanna rush things to get...

Griffin:

Oh, yeah.

Travis:

... to get back to that feeling.

Justin:

Oh, yeah.

Travis:

You miss that feeling.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Oh shit. Pump those breaks Paco please.

Travis:

Yeah. 'Cause you're not gonna get back to that, you know, spending all day cuddling in bed watching movies phase on the first date. You know?

Justin:

Nor it should be.

Travis:

Just be cool. Yeah. Just be cool. Low pressure situation. Uh, just be your awesome self.

Griffin:

This is that part... [crosstalk] This is a good chance for you to learn... you got to learn how to be totally cas.

Justin:

Yup. Yup.

Griffin:

You gotta be casually...

Justin:

But not so.... not sweatpants cas.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

But that part of relationship is your reward for doing all this dumb shit for a year or so.

Griffin:

Yup.

Justin:

But you gotta get there. You both gotta earn it. Um, and ladies, by the way, I wanted to make this clear. You too can have your own recovery sandwich.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

You probably want to put weirder things on it 'cause I think girls like weirder things on their sandwiches like bean sprouts.

Travis:

Like alfalfa sprouts, yeah.

Justin:

Like, yeah. Things... oh, god. [laughs] Yes.

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

Like alfalfa sprouts and avocado.

Griffin:

Yuck.

Justin:

Girls tend to like that stuff.

Griffin:

Yucky.

Travis:

Oo-ugh.

Griffin:

This sandwich is gross. I put... I mean, what would that, uh, for men... We're so— Man, we're so easy. We're so easy to pin down. Like, my recovery sandwich could literally be a sandwich.

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

I've eaten a sandwich that was so good that it helped heal my broken heart.

Travis:

Yes, pulled you right out of the doldrums.

Griffin:

Yeah, um...

Justin:

Just like Paul Blart fills in the cracks in his heart with pie.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

You with the, you know, the sandwich.

Griffin:

Uh...

Travis:

Mine is Goofy Movie.

Griffin:

Yeah. Goofy Movie's great. I'm... I mean, for guys it's, you know, going out and meeting another lady and having a good, good, low presh cas time with her.

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

Maybe it's something as simple as buying a whore.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

Yeah.

Griffin:

Maybe go rent a whore from the Rent-A-Center.

Justin:

[laughs]

Travis:

Mm-hmm. Well, rent-to-own and then after awhile if you decide to keep it, it's yours.

Griffin:

You got a whore wife!

Travis:

And you've already paid it off with no interest. It's wonderful!

Justin:

Hey, everybody. Travis just casually endorsed slavery. How's your Monday?

Griffin:

[laughs]

Justin:

Pretty good.

Griffin:

Oh.

Justin:

Griffin, uh, do you have a Yahoo! Answer to dig us out of this hole?

Griffin:

Yeah, let's cleanse our palate. Um, this one was sent in by Emily Bartholdt. Thank you Emily Bartholdt. It's by Yahoo! Answers user Derrick Muller or Mueller who asks, "Would you ever date a bounty hunter?"

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

This question is for women. The bounty hunter is a guy. I think we can...

Justin:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

...ignore that. That addendum. It's tough stuff.

Justin:

Are there female bounty hunters running around?

Griffin:

Oh, I... Oh, I hope so. I hope... They're just running around my mind...

Justin:

I can...

Griffin:

... and my dreams.

Justin:

I can actually prove that there aren't.

Griffin:

Okay.

Justin:

'Cause there's no series on the Discovery channel about 'em.

Travis:

Fair enough.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Right? Statistically speaking.

Griffin:

I mean, Dog the Bounty Hunter's wife does so much sort of, um, ancillary work for him. I think she qualifies as a bounty hunter, right? Like, she's a fucking tough broad.

Travis:

I think she's apprentice bounty hunter. I don't think she's a... she's...

Griffin:

No, I don't like that term.

Travis:

... uh, mastered it yet.

Griffin:

I don't like thinking of her as less of a bounty hunter just because she's of the fairer sex. I think that she is just...

Travis:

No, no, no. It's not that. I think she just hasn't started her own franchise yet.

Griffin:

Yeah, she's... The show's not called, you know, Glenda the Bounty Hunter or whatever...

Travis:

Exactly.

Griffin:

... the fuck her name is.

Travis:

That would be an awesome show though. Eustace the Bounty Hunter.

Griffin:

I don't know. I like the idea of that though. There has to... There has to be one. There has to be one. There has to be one. Yeah, because I... They have so many wiles and they can use those wiles to just entrap and snare a felon.

Travis:

Oh, their feminine wiles. Yeah. Yeah. Yeah.

Griffin:

I'm... Yeah. Um, uh, and also like, they're... like, maybe she's like a super tough feminine wile woman...

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

... who collects bounties on heads.

Travis:

Okay.

Griffin:

You know what sucks?

Travis:

That's it?

Griffin:

You know what job sucks?

Justin:

Tell me.

Griffin:

The bounty hunter. You know why?

Justin:

Why?

Griffin:

'Cause it's so... So glamorous at first, I bet.

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

Like, you see Boba Fett.

Justin:

Uh-huh.

Griffin:

And you're like, you know, like, I wanted that life. I want to be that guy.

Travis:

But it's not all Boba Fett.

Griffin:

But it's not all Boba Fett and Slave I's, which was the name of his ship and not...

Travis:

Uh-huh.

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

... a second endorsement of slavery on our show. Uh, it's all about, you know, jet packs and grappling hooks and blasters. But I think when you really get down to...

Travis:

You know, under that Mandalorian armor...

Griffin:

It's all about Mandalorian armor.

Travis:

... is a guy just putting in nine to five.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

You know, just punching the clock.

Griffin:

It's all about... Yeah. Um, but... Like, I bet it in the real practice of it, it's just a lot of paper pushing. It's just a lot of, you know, knocking on doors and sternly talking to a gentleman. Like...

Travis:

And if I've learned anything from Dog the Bunny Hunter, uh, Bounty Hunter, then you offer him a cigarette and then tell him about Jesus.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

If I'm not mistaken.

Griffin:

Yeah. It's like I'm gonna take you in. Like, you are going to the big house but you can also go to the big house in the sky when you... if you... if...

Travis:

I might kill you.

Griffin:

I have good news for you. Well, the bad news is you're going to jail. The good news is, ever lasting life. 'Sup?

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

The question is though, could you ever date one?

Justin:

Mm, no.

Travis:

Oh, no.

Justin:

No.

Griffin:

I don't think so.

Justin:

Well, it... you... what if you committed a crime around them? The...

Griffin:

Oh, my god.

Justin:

The bounty.

Travis:

Oh, then it becomes a Harrison Ford movie.

Justin:

Right.

Griffin:

Actually becomes a Gerald Butler, Jennifer Aniston feature called...

Travis:

Oh, gross.

Griffin:

Oh no. I pulled that out. Put that away, Griffin!

Justin:

Now what's the hit name of that hit film?

Griffin:

Uh, it's called, uh, Bounty for Love.

Justin:

No, it's not.

Griffin:

It's called... Friends 2.

Justin:

It's really creative.

Griffin:

Oh, it was called...

Justin:

Friends With... Friends With Bounties.

Griffin:

Friend With Bounties. Um...

Justin:

FWB.

Griffin:

I think it was called The Price on Your Head is Love.

Justin:

[laughs] Can you hold my helmet?

Griffin:

It's called...

Justin:

Am I in Slave I?

Travis:

It's actually called, uh, The Bounty Hugger.

Justin:

Uh... Yes, we will allow it. I had to [crosstalk].

Travis:

Yes, oh god. Right at the wire. Woo.

Justin:

Yeah. Got it in, in underneath there. Um...

Griffin:

It's called Jennifer Aniston's done everybody. Wave goodbye to her.

Justin:

She had a good run.

Griffin:

Mm-hmm. It's called The Emasculation of Gerard Butler.

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

The Movie in movie form. I think I could love a bounty hunter.

Justin:

You think you could?

Griffin:

I think I...

Justin:

Well, of course you'd love 'em. It's about the relationship you know what I mean?

Travis:

Could you put up with the long hours and the sitting up at nights wondering if they've hunted their bounty or not?

Griffin:

Yeah. I think I would love her so much that none of that other stuff would matter, you know?

Travis:

Mm.

Justin:

Griffin, I want to tell you that normally this a comedy show but you've really inspired me today and I want to thank you for that.

Griffin:

To become a bounty hunter? You'd be...

Justin:

Nah, not...

Griffin:

... great at it Justin. You would be phenomenal.

Travis:

You would be. You are insatiable. You would... Like, you would... Just tenacious.

Griffin:

Yeah. Yeah. You're unswerving.

Justin:

When I get my...

Griffin:

Once you have a mark, you just chase 'em down until you get your prize...

Justin:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

... and you send them to heaven.

Justin:

Like, when I get my mind set on something, I can't be stopped.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

Yeah. And you look damn fine in a bulletproof vest.

Justin:

Like...

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

... for instance, right now I really need to use the bathroom and even though we're recording the show, I'm just gonna put my headphones on my mic and go do it and then come right back.

Griffin:

See? No big deal.

Travis:

Unswerving. Justin?

Griffin:

No, he's for real using the bathroom.

Travis:

Justin:

I need to talk to everybody. [laughs] If you... Okay. Listen. I want to address a specific branch of spitting even though I don't know this is what they're specifically talking about but it is in the family. I don't endorse the use of any tobacco products except for...

Travis:

Uh-huh.

Justin:

... the ones that I myself use.

Griffin:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

But...

Griffin:

Snuffs.

Justin:

Snuff and pot and pipe.

Griffin:

No, no, no. I'm sorry. Snooffs.

Travis:

Snooffs.

Justin:

Snuffs.

Travis:

Snooze.

Justin:

Hey. Hey everybody, stop dipping.

Travis:

Oh, my god. It's the grossest thing.

Justin:

It's the worst thing that ever happened to anybody when they see you do it.

Griffin:

Mm.

Justin:

Everybody wants to die and they hate you for doing it. Please stop it.

Travis:

Sometimes I like to picture, like, the smartest people in the world. Great philosophers and great scientists, like, in the middle of a speech just reaching down and grabbing their empty Coke bottle and like just letting some brown spittle dribble out of their mouths into it.

Justin:

Do you know what a fucking monster you look like?

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

I'm not joking with you right now. Stop it. There is my anti-dipping message for the... Ugh, ugh.

Griffin:

I, um, if you're gonna do it, practice safe chawing. If you're gonna chew. If you're gonna skoal it, like, at least be safe and smart about it. I worked in a movie theater for awhile and where I was, uh, I was a, uh, not an usher. What's the... Who are the dudes who do like clean and... I was one of the dudes that like clean the theater out afterwards at night.

Justin:

You were a janitor.

Griffin:

I was a janitor basically, um, but like a...

Justin:

Custodian.

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

I was a custodian for the movie theater and I would go in after John Cena's The Marine. I would go in after that showing and, uh, this was deep in the heart of West Virginia and there would be cups just, uh, like, those Dixie cups and people would just have them sitting on the floor. I would come up like sweeping. Like, oh. Let me get this half drunk Dixie cup of coke out of... Oh no. It's...

Justin:

It's spittle.

Griffin:

... human expectorate! It's fucking...

Travis:

[laughs].

Griffin:

It came from your mouth after you swashed it around with chaw and skoal. You're fucking gross. Like, put the... You couldn't pick that up and throw it in the garage can? You couldn't because you didn't want people to see you carrying around a cup of your own spit. Like...

Travis:

Your own warm human spit.

Griffin:

Your own warm... That came from your body, dog. Like, I don't come to your house and, like, fucking jerk off in a...

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

...in some sort of container and just like, "I'm gonna leave this on the floor. We cool?" We are not cool. Don't do that.

Travis:

Everyone who has ever made the argument that smoking looks cool, it's, like, a million times the opposite for dipping. Like, I don't understand the appeal of it.

Justin:

There is zero appeal. I would rather eat a cigar.

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

I'd rather... I'd rather feed a cigar to a baby then...

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

... then have... then anyone ever dip again, but I think this person's talking about spit.

Griffin:

Do you know...

Travis:

Just like normal spit?

Griffin:

... how not cool you look when you have it in your lip even? You look like you're...

Travis:

You look like you have a tumor. You look like you have a tumor on your face.

Griffin:

You look like you just started... you started eating a grape and then you stopped. You just gave up on it.

Travis:

And you said, "I'll save this for later."

Griffin:

This is mine now. You look like a fucking hamster. Only a gross hamster with brown lips. Go home.

Travis:

Okay. So. But spitting, here's the thing, I don't even understand why someone, I... As much as I don't understand dipping and spitting, why would a human being just spit for no reason? Like, what is stopping them from holding their saliva in their mouth?

Justin:

Just swallow it. Like, we're all walking around swallowing it.

Griffin:

Oh, fuck. Okay. Oh. Okay. Okay. Okay. Let's set some ground rules 'cause we are entering some pretty gross territory in this question and I don't want to tread. Don't say that.

Travis:

No. You do it everyday. You just don't think about it.

Griffin:

Just regulate your own... Just regulate your fluids without like without, like, without showing 'em. Just don't let things that are in your body, out of your body. Can that be a rule? Just like, I don't want to see... Uh, I don't get to watch... Uh, and by get I mean have. I don't have to watch you pee or make bathroom. Like, I don't have to make you, uh, watch you make bathroom or...

Justin:

You know, Griffin doesn't have to watch you pee. It's a privilege.

Griffin:

I don't have to watch you make...

Travis:

It's a privilege, not a right.

Griffin:

Yeah. I am not forced to watch you make jerksies but like...

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

I don't... I don't see anything... If you have a fluid in your body, fucking leave it there. Don't spit in front of me. Don't pee or two in front of me. Don't cry in front of me either.

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

I don't even want...

Justin:

Ooo.

Griffin:

... to see you sweat.

Travis:

Okay, but hold on to that. I'm gonna turn it around.

Justin:

Unless, unless your rocking the mic.

Travis:

I'm wanna turn it around.

Justin:

[crosstalk] Okay.

Travis:

I want to bring back spittoons.

Griffin:

Oh...

Justin:

No, no. Even worse.

Griffin:

That's science's...

Travis:

No.

Griffin:

That's... Science's grossest invention, I think, is the spittoon 'cause...

Travis:

But it gives you an outlet, a receptacle.

Griffin:

Yeah, a community hodgepodge of human spit. A miasma of human fluid that is mixed together like a broth. Like a rolling broth.

Justin:

It would make daring people to drink stuff more convenient.

Griffin:

Oh...

Travis:

Yeah.

Griffin:

...fucking stop it.

Justin:

'Cause a lot of times...

Travis:

And you just knew you could just go to the spittoon.

Justin:

A lot of times I want to dare someone to drink something and I don't have anything really good there.

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

And if I try to do something weird, Pepsi's probably already made of soda based on it. Like, there's...

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

... not a lot of options anymore. People like so many weird things.

Griffin:

Can we... Can we... Let's build off of this. Can we make a private...

Justin:

Okay.

Griffin:

... spittoon? Like a secret spittoon if you do absolutely need to spit. I mean...

Travis:

Do you mean like a mask? Like, like it hangs on your face?

Griffin:

Mm, no. 'Cause I don't... Then people would still have to see it. I'm talking about like a flask, Like a secret flask that you spit into very discretely. Even that's gonna be kind of gross, though.

Travis:

So I was thinking more like a gas mask where it was like a full face thing and so then the receptacle's right below your mouth but no one could see it or you.

Griffin:

That's pretty nice.

Justin:

That would be pretty good. What about like a... Well, you know how we have, you know, you have a St. Bernard with the barrel...

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

... of hot cocoa, um, on it... around it's neck. You can just have something like that but it would be a spittoon.

Griffin:

Like a cask. Like a spit pendant?

Travis:

Are you saying like a dog that follows you around and you spit on the dog?

Justin: Has anybody ever seen a... [laughs] All right. Wait. What? No!

Griffin:

What's wrong with...

Travis:

Collect my spittle, St. Bernard! Spit, spit, spit.

Griffin:

Come on, Sparky.

Travis:

That's the saddest dog life.

Griffin:

Hey, why does your dog look really sad?

Travis:

[laughs] All the time. Really sad and moist.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

[laughs] I spit on my dog all the time.

Travis: Um, it's a living.

Justin:

It is? **Griffin:** ...a living though?

Justin:

[laughs] It's a dog. It's like, you're spitting on your dog. Tell your friend to stop spitting on their dog.

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

And every time they spit, I want them to imagine a St. Bernard there, you know, with the cask and what all. Like, they're spitting on him.

Travis:

Mm.

Justin:

Just remember Jesus is all around us. So every time we spit, you're spitting on him, technically.

Griffin:

Yup.

Justin:

And if you believe your grandparents are all around us watching you after they past away, you're spitting on everyone's dead grandparents. So stop it.

Griffin:

Oh, wouldn't that be dope if you spit and, like, it just sort of hung in the air and you're like, "What?" And it'd be like, "Oh, you spit on grandpa." It's like, "You found me."

Justin:

[laughs]

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

"No!"

Justin:

"Dang you kids!"

Griffin:

[crosstalk] ...heaven.

Justin:

"I was going to watch The Marine with you."

Griffin:

[laughs]

Justin:

"But I'm caught and have to go to hell." Um, listen. [laughs] Let's move on.

Travis:

Yup.

Griffin:

Don't fucking spit.

Justin:

I feel like we've helped this...

Griffin:

What you do is you... if your friend spits, you go to where... you go and you pick up his leavings and you rub it on his nose and you say, "No."

Travis:

I think it's a justifiable experience. I think it's justifiable to just smack him in the face every time he does... It's just so uncalled for...

Griffin:

Just...

Travis:

...to just spit on the ground wherever you happen to be. When he does it, you smack him just, like, every time.

Griffin:

Push.

Travis:

I guarantee that will stop so fast.

Griffin:

Push his nose into his leavings. That's the only thing you can do.

Travis:

[laughs] "No!"

Griffin:

"No."

Travis:

"No."

Justin:

Shake the no-no can at him also.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Um, well, I don't have a good transition for this, but money time!

[ad break]

Justin:

Hey, Joe Willens called us and he wanted us to wish his friend James Band a very, very happy birthday.

Griffin:

Hey.

Justin:

Yeah. Hey Jim, James. We'll go with James. Uh, James is studying math and English lit at Swarthmore College. Plays guitar. It's big 21 and he is, uh, and he's the one who got Joe into our show. So thanks James...

Griffin:

Can we suggest Joe...

Justin:

... for spreading the word.

Griffin:

Can we suggest Joe a kickoff drink into this new world that's he entering into? And Justin, if you say Code Red and Vodka, I am going to quit the show.

Justin:

Okay. Well, let me suggest maybe Mountain Dew and a little bit of grenadine and vodka.

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

Okay. What you just described is some sort of home brewed Code Red.

Justin:

Little of your own blend.

Griffin:

Talking about...

Justin:

It's all...

Griffin:

DIY nerd beverages.

Justin:

Yeah. DIY. Your own blend. **Travis:** I actually just invented a new drink that I would to suggest called the southern gentleman.

Griffin:

I can't wait to hear this.

Travis:

No, it's delicious. It's, uh, a Bombay Sapphire gin and, uh, sweet tea and a little bit of lemon.

Justin:

Oh, I've had one of those. You mean a frat house blackout.

Travis:

[laughs] No. It's delicious and goes down smooth and you drink it on your back porch while you appreciate having land.

Griffin:

When do you... When do you put mustard and salt and cheese on it and jalapenos?

Travis:

That's the third one.

Griffin:

And then you pour the drink on a bagel and you just...

Travis:

Uh-huh.

Griffin:

... party down.

Travis:

Yup. **Justin:** And then I puke on you. By the way, the one time it's permissible to spit is when Travis makes you some food and feeds it to you. When you take a bite of Travis' lunch, you will biologically need to spit that out.

Travis:

I imagine the sandwiches I make are like the sweet embrace of death. Where you're just so happy to go but you know it's the end.

Griffin:

What's the opposite of a recovery sandwich?

Travis:

[laughs] Uh, the punishment sandwich.

Griffin:

A debilitation sandwich is the...

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

... Travis [mumbles].

Justin:

Um.

Griffin:

"I feel lonelier. And what's... I feel lonelier from eating this."

Justin:

[laughs] "This is a backwards... This is a backwards concoction I've made." Um, so thank you to Joe. Um, if you'd like to, uh, wish someone a happy birthday or promote your business or what have you, get in touch with us. It's, uh, MaximumFun.org/jumbotron. Get a ad of your very own.

Griffin:

Hey, I... What about Yahoo!

Justin:

What... Oh yeah. We've got it on smooth.

Griffin:

Um, this one was sent in by Brussel Sprout. Probably not a real Christian name, but we'll roll with it. Thank you Brussel Sprout. It's by Yahoo! Answers user MyCollegeFund1988 who asks, "Can I sneak my cat on a plane? She is a kitten, about a month old, and I was thinking about putting her in my pocket while I went through security. My pocket is loose and since she'll be, uh, on me, she won't be on my stuff that's being x-rayed. All I have to do is walk through a metal detector. Do you think this is possible?"

Justin:

What the fuck?

Griffin:

What the fuck are... What the fuck?

Travis:

What life are you living?

Justin:

How much do you love that kitty?

Travis: [laughs] **Justin:** How much do you simultaneously love-hate your cat that you want it to be with you but you also want it in your pocket for x hours?

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

Oh, god. I guess that this is like a baby with a cup full of bleach. I just want to smack it away from it and be like, "No. You can't have that cat!"

Griffin:

Don't you see the Mr. Yuck sticker? You will die.

Travis:

Oh, god. Oh, Jesus.

Justin:

So, how can we make this happen?

Griffin:

How can we...

Justin:

All right. How loose...

Travis:

Clearly it's the cat hat. It's a big cowboy hat and the cat sits underneath the hat.

Griffin:

Yeah. I'm pretty sure you have to take those off.

Justin:

I like that.

Griffin:

[laughs] As charming as that...

Travis:

No, you tell him it's...

Griffin:

Sir, you have to take off that 10 gallon hat. It's... Well, first of all, it's, uh, illegal. Second of all, it's ridiculous.

Travis:

Tell him it's prescription.

Griffin:

And you say...

Travis:

It's a prescription hat.

Griffin:

"Sure thing, madam." And you take it off and your cat is standing perfectly on your head.

Travis:

Oh... [laughs] No, the cat's doing that thing where it's holding its arms and legs up against the sides of the hat and keeping itself inside the hat. It's like, "Well, this looks okay." And you put the hat back on and that's how the cat...

Griffin:

And it has its own...

Travis:

... sneaks in.

Griffin:

... smaller cowboy hat on it.

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

Yee-haw.

Griffin:

I don't... We're not even helping anymore, but I'm just making beautiful tableaux.

Justin:

Uh, these tableaux are pretty beautiful. I... There was of course a pretty obvious with this plan that we're not, um, that we're not dealing with here and that's cats have metal skeletons.

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

You see a cat jump off of something high, it... you don't hear the snapping of bones. You hear like the clanging of metal on metal.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Um, that's how they're able to survive falls from great distances, 'cause cats...

Griffin:

You make a great point Justin.

Justin:

... have metal skeletons.

Griffin:

You're gonna have to get those bones out of that cat.

Travis:

[laughs] Yup.

Justin:

Can you put... Can you put the cat's bones in your checked luggage?

Griffin:

[laughs]

Justin:

Oh, who are we fucking kidding. This guy's not gonna get a cat carrier but he's gonna spring to check a bag. No, he's going full carry on.

Griffin:

Well, the problem is you can't...

Travis:

Let me suggest...

Griffin:

It's not the... It's not the transporting the cat. He cannot go. He is flying from fucking Denver to Seattle and he needs to have that cat with him for that three hour drive.

Justin:

Yeah.

Travis:

Okay, I've got it. Tell the airline it's a service animal.

Griffin:

Okay. How can we do this. What is this cat doing...

Travis:

This is my service kitten. **Justin:** I have a severe nuzzle deficiency.

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

Sometime I need to get snuggled out mid-flight.

Griffin:

Is anybody on this plane capable of snuggling?

Travis:

[laughs] Is there a snuggler on the plane?

Griffin:

This man took the bones out of his cat. It is no longer capable of anything. It is a cat bag.

Justin:

[laughs] Boy, how, how much is he going to regret wearing his My Kitty's The Bomb t-shirt?

Griffin:

Oh, no.

Justin:

Why did you even pick that one?

Justin:

Mm. That's gonna make for some awkward conversation with the... with the guy. And cats are weapons by the way. Duh.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

I feel like this person isn't really thinking through the endgame of this question. Like...

Justin:

Oh, you mean a cat funeral for your baby kitten?

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

'Cause you had it in your pocket and its brains exploded with the... cabin was pressurized?

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

Uh, uh, god. I hate this person.

Griffin:

Like...

Justin:

I hate him too.

Griffin:

What if your pilot is allergic to cats? Didn't...

Justin:

Yeah.

Griffin:

... think about that one did you?

Justin:

Great.

Griffin:

What are you gonna do...

Justin:

Oh, my god.

Griffin:

... when mewling starts coming from your pockets? What are you gonna do?

Justin:

He's gonna know.

Travis:

Although it does make for the cutest sequel to Snakes On A Plane.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Single Kitten On A Plane.

Travis:

[laughs] Yeah. I gotta get this motherfuckin' adorable ass kitten off this motherfuckin' plane.

Justin:

I need to get this, uh, fucking adorable single kitten, harmless...

Griffin:

Just the one.

Justin:

Just the one salt and pepper fur... One calico...

Griffin:

This sweet precious tabby pussy.

Travis:

[laughs]

Griffin:

Get 'em off the plane. Open that door.

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

Ladies and gentlemen, Cobra Starship, play us out.

Griffin:

Can you... Can you drug mule this cat?

Justin:

[whispering] Do you mean...

Travis:

Are you saying put the cat up your butt?

Griffin:

Can you even though? But in you somehow.

Justin:

Can put the cat in a shampoo...

Griffin:

It... Get this cat in you.

Justin:

A shampoo bottle in your butt. Is that what you're saying?

Griffin:

I doesn't have to... You guys are not... You guys are not aware of the recent developments in drug mule, uh, technology.

Justin:

Oh, okay. Put the cat in your urethra.

Travis:

Yeah, put it right in your wiener.

Griffin:

[panicked noises] Ugh, it's in my... Oh, the picture. Oh, the picture's in there!

Justin:

Just do like I do at the buffet. Put him in a sandwich bag.

Travis:

[laughs] And in your cargo pants.

Justin:

Put it in your cargo pants. That's what cargo pants are for.

Griffin:

This is a tiny kitty. Can you keep him in your mouth? "Uh, sir, you're being very quiet." [imitates muffled talking and meows]

Travis:

"Sir, can I get you anything to drink?" "Milk."

Justin:

[laughs]

Griffin:

[laughs] Cat formula.

Justin:

And sardine. Sardines if you have them.

Travis:

What about buying him an extra ticket and then dressing him like a tiny human being?

Griffin:

See, this is...

Justin:

I love it.

Griffin:

This is gonna be great, especially if it's a Garfield. Especially if it's bipedal cat with human features.

Travis:

Oh, and he's wearing a tiny suit and you make him look like, uh, like a foreigner!

Griffin:

Sorry?

Travis:

And that's why he doesn't speak any English and you translate for him!

Justin:

Okay. Okay. Uh, I think that this person doesn't wanna buy an extra ticket 'cause they can probably just put the god damn cat in a box and buy it a ticket.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Right. Isn't that the way these things work?

Griffin:

Cats are... Cats are solo maintenance. You can just fucking FedEx him to your... to your final destination.

Travis:

Just do what the cat wants and let it go. Just open your front door and let the cat leave free.

Griffin:

Just... Let the cat run away.

Travis:

That's what the cat wants to do.

Griffin:

If he loves you, he will find you as your final destination, fucking Homeward Bound style.

Justin:

Fuck yes.

Griffin:

That would be way hard...

Justin:

Just how were... Wait, wait, wait, wait, wait. Why are you even flying with the cat? Just Homeward Bound it. It's gonna be... It'll... Leave the door open. It will Homeward Bound to you and then on your return trip, it will Homeward Bound back.

Griffin:

Let him get a real good whiff of your musk and....

Justin:

Uh-huh.

Griffin:

... then just let him trace you through the sky.

Justin:

Yeah, no problem.

Travis:

Just pray to god he doesn't Milo and Otis it.

Griffin:

Oh, no.

Justin:

Oh, no.

Travis:

That's a bad scene.

Griffin:

You really don't want this...

Justin:

Great.

Griffin:

... cat to Marly and Me it.

Justin:

[laughs] Uh, no. Um...

Griffin:

Air Bud would be cool though. Let your cat play some sports.

Justin:

Yeah. "Hey, what are a few not incredibly obvious ways of finding out if a girl you like has a boyfriend or not? I'm currently in university and don't really know how to bring up that topic without the girl realizing that I'm into her." That's from Confuzzled In Cincinnati.

Griffin:

You goosed her. Why...

Travis:

I have a theory.

Griffin:

Let's hear it.

Travis:

But I would like you guys to, uh, refute or agree with and that means that if the girl has a boyfriend and she is not into you, she will mention it awkwardly, like, in the first four sentences.

Justin:

[laughs]

Travis:

Am I wrong? But she'll be like talk, talk, talk. Well, I guess I better go meet my boyfriend.

Griffin:

Nah. No. No. I don't think that... Well, it depends on the, the... What... What kind of girl are we talking about? 'Cause if she's... if she's the kind of person who thinks that everybody is into them...

Travis:

Uh-huh.

Griffin:

... then first off, you shouldn't be pursuing her 'cause that's not an attractive trait. Um, I don't know. That seems like it would put, like, more people off than it would... I don't know Travis. I don't think that's true.

Justin:

I have a really... I have a really cool move.

Griffin:

Okay.

Justin:

Ask her out.

Griffin:

Yeah, that's...

Justin:

And then-.

Griffin:

Why are you afraid...

Travis:

But that's bold.

Griffin:

...of letting her realize that your into her? Like that's sort of the thing...

Travis:

Can I make a metaphor here? Like, but that's like rather than asking someone if they're allergic to peanuts, just shove some peanuts in their face.

Justin:

No, it's not like that. It's like asking them out and then, uh... Think about this move okay. You ask her out. She says yes. You go on a date. You get married. Have kids. Wonderful. You ask her out. She says...

Travis:

Shows that she has her boyfriend.

Justin:

You ask her... Yeah, later. No. You ask her out. She says, "I got a boyfriend." You look at her dead in the eye and you say, "The question stands." Oh, my god!

Travis:

Ooh! **Griffin:** What!? **Travis:** That is kind of badass.

Justin:

How smooth would that be?

Travis:

That is pretty awesome.

Griffin:

God, that would be cool.

Justin:

You won't sell it.

Griffin:

No, no, no.

Justin:

I'm not. I'm reading your question. You're not just selling...

Travis:

Yeah, it's not gonna work for you.

Griffin:

And then she'll be like, "Okay." And you'll be like, "Oh, I can't. I can't be party to cheating." And then you walk away. How's your double power play?

Justin:

Oh, you just convinced her to sin and then refuse the sin back in her face.

Griffin:

That move is gonna be so...

Justin:

You're gonna be alone tonight but it's a moral victory.

Griffin:

Move is gonna be so dope, you're gonna need a hype man to, like, walk behind you like, "What, what, what?"

Travis:

[laughs] Ooh! Ooh!

Griffin:

It hurts! Pickup your face!

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

Have you guys ever... Have you guys ever been in a conversation with a member of the opposite sex and they will work into the conversation that they have a boyfriend or a girlfriend, I guess, if you were a girl? Um, and, like, you know that they're saying that so you won't ask them out but you weren't that interested in the first place.

Travis:

Yeah.

Justin:

You guys ever had that? I love that and... **Travis:** But then I get... I get affronted at that point. It's like if somebody...

Justin:

"I wasn't going to but now I can't!"

Travis:

Yeah. Well, now I'm just mad. And then I ask them out. Like, I'm like, "Uh, so do you wanna get coffee?" Uh, and they're like, "I just mentioned I had a boyfriend." I'm like, "Uh yeah, yeah, yeah. I get that. I get that."

Griffin:

Do you know what...

Travis:

"So you like a movie or dinner?"

Griffin:

Do you know what is fucking horse apples? Do you know what is fucking horse apples is that we had to deal with that shit, like, me probably all the way up through high school, um, but now that Facebook's up and it's like...

Justin:

Oh.

Griffin:

Justin:

Mm-hmm.

Travis:

... but not a girl that he likes. Like he doesn't know. He's not into her. He's attracted to her. He doesn't like her.

Justin:

This bitch can't get on Facebook and you think that you're gonna fix his vocab. Like, come on.

Travis:

Fair enough.

Justin:

Cut him some slack. He's trying to get his shit together.

Travis:

Fair enough. **Justin:**

Hey listen. I'm sorry Confuzzled. I'm sorry about that. I'm sorry things got heated in here. Just get on Facebook. Tweet at her.

Griffin:

Tweet at her and find out her status... her Twitter status. Get on Facebook. Look at every picture of her that's ever been taken and look for fucking common dudes. Like a dude who... a repeated dude. Like, "Oh, that dude's in a lot of pictures. They're, they're probably."

Travis:

Justin:

Griffin:

But she'd be like, "I didn't make one up."

Travis:

Griffin:

That's... This is... I'm gonna go.

Justin:

"Oh, my girlfriend and I want to know if you want to come to a couples ministry with me and her 'cause she's real and you and your boyfriend."

Travis:

Oh, and then it becomes an Adam Sandler movie.

Griffin:

Mm-hmm.

Justin:

Yeah, then you had to pay somebody. But you already own a whore, right
Travis?

Travis:

Yup. **Justin:** Hey, perfect. **Travis:** Well, I'm still paying it off.

Justin:

Yeah. Right. Um, "I'm a senior in college and this semester I've nabbed one of the much coveted single rooms. Issue is this is my first time in my life I've ever lived alone. I'm five days in and I can already feel my mental health slipping away. Any tips on surviving the lonely times?" That's from Nick.

Griffin:

I've got a great tip. Go find a roommate before you hang yourself.

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

I've never tried this. I don't know how well I would adjust to it.

Griffin:

I... This is not...

Justin:

Um.

Griffin:

... a joke. I did it for about three months and it...

Justin:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

... was so miserable that, uh, I... one of my friends moved in with me.

Travis:

I did it for about three months and lost my mind...

Griffin:

It sucks.

Travis:

... to a point where I was just walking around talking to myself...

Griffin:

Yeah.

Travis:

... out loud all the time.

Justin:

Your best bet is gonna be... And, like, I have some experience with this. I haven't lived alone but, like, I work at my house and pretty much all my, uh, you know, day to day is like here. Um, I find that you gotta get out as much as humanly possible. Like, go to Starbucks. Don't sit at home and watch a movie. Like, go to the theater. Like, just be around people. Um, but...

Griffin:

My folly...

Justin:

Griffin:

Justin:

Griffin:

Griffin:

Oh.

Travis:

Griffin:

Justin:

No.

Travis:

No.

Griffin:

It is super hard to do that and not feel like a total pedophile.

Justin:

[laughs]

Travis:

Justin:

Yeah.

Griffin:

I think if you're alone at a pool, I think people are looking at you like, "Oh, that's a... there's a pedophile. Confirmed."

Travis:

You know, I feel the same way about going to MagiQuest by myself.

Griffin: Well...

Justin:

Griffin:

Travis:

Nope.

Griffin:

Travis:

[laughs] That is not a good substitute.

Griffin:

Justin:

Right.

Griffin:

So don't do that.

Justin:

This is key. Don't do that.

Griffin:

This is... This is so important.

Justin:

Don't lose yourself in the world of computer games.

Griffin:

You gotta leave the house. You gotta take up a hobby. You gotta find a roommate.

Justin:

Yeah.

Griffin:

Go quick.

Justin:

Yup.

Griffin:

Quick before the semester is... it gets too deep in.

Justin:

Stop. Stop listening. **Travis:** What happened to me in that three months I lived by myself is I was constantly contacting everyone I knew. I'd be like, "Do you guys want to come over? I can come over there. We can go grab some pizza, get a beer, whatever."

Griffin:

"Hey, I got some really cool records."

Travis:

And eventually, like, I burned out everyone.

Griffin:

"Do you wanna come hear 'em? [crosstalk 00:46:51]"

Travis:

"Just come sit with me please. Just sit here. Be another living person in the same 10 feet square as me please."

Griffin:

"Travis, are you trying to hold my hand right now?"

Justin:

"When, uh, when you guys are done swimming, you kids wanna come by? I got some like cheese balls. We can watch a movie or whatever. See what's on TBS."

Travis:

"Got some Code Red Mountain Dew. Just see what happens."

Justin:

"Get some Mountain Dew and grenadine. Just make your own. It's not big deal."

Griffin:

You know what you should do actually?

Justin:

What?

Griffin:

Just get super lonely this year. Justin, it's a...

Justin:

[singing] Don't it always seem to go that you don't know what you've got till its gone.

Griffin:

Here's the problem. Uh, the only problem is your senior year in college and you're supposed to be making memories and stuff. Doing all that shit but, um...

Justin:

Uh-huh.

Griffin:

And so it's unfortunate that these two stars have aligned in this manner but you gotta have a lonely year. I think we all have a lonely year and that lonely year is so important to your... to your formation as a human being, as a man.

Travis:

Do you know who I bet has a lot of strong memories?

Griffin:

Who's that?

Travis:

Uh, Tom Hank's character in Castaway.

Griffin:

Yeah, sure. Tom Hank's character in Castaway knows exactly who Tom Hank's character, character in Castaway is even though we cannot recall his name.

Justin:

It's Wilson.

Griffin:

Yeah. That was...

Travis:

Griffin:

Justin:

Griffin:

Get lonely Nick. Really live in it. Just live in that loneliness. It'll get better.

Justin:

Wallow.

Griffin:

Just wallow in that loneliness...

Justin:

Yeah, have a lonely year... have a lonely year even though both of my brothers just said they managed to last three months.

Travis:

Mm-hmm.

Griffin:

Fucking...

Travis:

You gotta push yourself. Push yourself to the brink.

Justin:

Do as we do, not as we something. I don't know.

Travis:

Yeah. Something along those lines.

Justin:

Griffin.

Griffin:

I have a Yahoo for us.

Justin:

You better.

Griffin:

Uh, this one was sent in by Alex Siegler. It's by Yahoo... Oh, thank you Alex. It's been Yahoo Answers user Crest who asks, "Is it okay for guys to skinny dip together? Griffin:

Travis:

Justin:

No, there's like all the...

Travis:

... and get back in the car naked and drive home naked.

Griffin:

You guys wanna go skinny driving?

Justin:

All the world's most...

Travis:

[laughs]

Justin:

All the worlds most tasteful colognes and just that smell melding into like one like gay ambrosia? Like, yeah. I think you should probably get off Yahoo Answers and go...

Travis:

Can we say manbrosia?

Justin:

Manbrosia.

Griffin:

Yeah.

Justin:

Uh, but like okay. If you're... If... I'm assuming by okay, does this writer, this question asker does not mean is it cool for my, um, me and all my other, uh, gay male friends...

Griffin:

Does it.

Justin:

Griffin:

Travis:

Travis:
